Clerk of Court Announces Changes to Filing Fees Due to Georgia Senate Bill 322

Cherokee County Georgia – June 13, 2024– The Clerk of Court is announcing changes to filing fees, effective July 01, 2024, as a result of the recent passage of Georgia Senate Bill 322. This legislation mandates adjustments to the fee structure for various court filings to ensure compliance with state requirements.

New Fee Structure:

- **State and Superior Civil actions: \$218.00**
- **Post Judgments: \$62.00**
- **Magistrate fees: from \$57.00 to \$61.00**
- **Abandoned vehicle cases: \$50.00**
- **Notary fees: from \$51.00 to \$55.00**
- **Trade Name Registrations: \$175.00**

These changes are implemented to align with the provisions set forth by Senate Bill 322 and to maintain the efficiency and sustainability of court operations.

Impact on Court Users:

The revised fee structure will impact all individuals and entities filing documents with the Clerk of Court's office. We understand that changes in fees can affect our community, and we are committed to providing a smooth transition.
